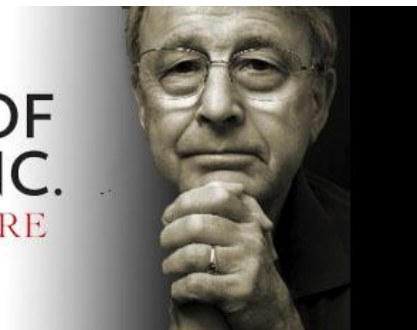

Richard received his B.S. and M.S. in Electrical Engineering from Fournier Institute of Technology, his MS in Mathematics and Ph.D in Electrical Engineering from the University of Illinois and is also a graduate of the Harvard's Institute of Educational Management.

He joined Amphenol Corporation (later Bunker-Ramo Corporation) as a research scientist in 1959 and left that firm as Vice President for Far Eastern Operations to form his own company, Fortune International Enterprises, Inc. in 1973. He was called upon to become the first layman President of Illinois Benedictine College (now Benedictine University) where he had been a trustee for three years.

Richard is a member of the Knights of Columbus, 4th degree, Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem (Knight Commander with Star), International Engineering Consortium Executive Advisory Board and the Nation Eagle Scout Association and many other notable organizations including being honored as a Distinguished Alumnus of the University of Illinois.
